To ensure collection, please observe the following:

COLLECTION REQUIREMENTS

- ➤ All items curbside by 6:00 a.m.
- Containers within 6 feet of the curb
- Do not mix garbage, yard waste or recyclables
- Containers can not exceed 50 pounds
- Containers can not exceed 50 gallons
- > Yard waste collection is limited to 15 bags, bundles or cans per pickup day
- > Yard waste bundles must be secured with string or twine
- > Yard waste can not exceed 4 inch diameter per branch
- Yard waste bundles can not exceed 4 feet in length
- Bulky items such as appliances, furniture, fencing and other bulky household items are collected by calling your hauler at 407-774-0800 to schedule the curbside pick up.



RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

In one recycling bin:

- · Pasteboard (i.e., cereal boxes, empty paper towel and toilet paper rolls, soda boxes, beer boxes, tissue boxes, gift boxes, pizza boxes and shoe boxes
- · Brown paper grocery bags (no wax, no wet strength material, no liners)
- Corrugated cardboard (flattened and cut down to no larger than 3 ft. by 3 ft.)
- Newspaper, supplements, magazines and catalogs
- Telephone Books

In another recycling bin:

- Plastic #1-7 (#'s on bottom of containers) Remove all lids
- Glass bottles and jars (clear, green and brown) Remove all lids
- Aluminum cans
- Steel cans and tin household containers, such as food cans and empty aerosol cans

Please rinse out all containers and discard lids!
